Refreshments will follow the program. The Coalition will raise a toast to Thomas Garrett, Delaware's most famous Underground Railroad Stationmaster, on the 228th anniversary of his birth (August 21, 1789).

Traveling North from I-95:

Exit 6 (Martin Luther King Blvd., Maryland Avenue); at the bottom of the exit ramp stay in the far right lane and turn right onto Maryland Avenue; turn right onto Martin Luther King Blvd.; stay in second to last left hand lane; follow signs to turn left onto Orange Street. After turning left onto Orange, make a right hand turn onto Sixth Street. If you wish to park on Shipley Street, you can turn right here. If you wish to park on King Street, follow Sixth Street to King Street, make a right onto King Street, and get into the far left hand lane for the Courthouse parking lot.

The **Delaware History Museum, Jane and Littleton Mitchell Center for African American Heritage**, and **Old Town Hall** are at 504 North Market Street, under the arch!

Traveling South from I-95:

Exit 6 (Martin Luther King Blvd., stay in second to last left hand lane; follow signs to turn left onto Orange Street. After turning left onto Orange, make a right at Sixth Street. If you wish to park on Shipley Street, you can turn right here. If you wish to park on King Street, follow Sixth Street to King Street, make a right onto King Street, and get into the far left hand lane for the Courthouse parking lot.

The **Delaware History Museum, Jane and Littleton Mitchell Center for African American Heritage**, and **Old Town Hall** are at 504 North Market Street, under the arch!

Parking: On the street on Market, numbered side streets, and Shipley Street near the Museum. Parking is also available, after hours, in the surface lot at 6th and Shipley Streets, one block west of the Museum.
