August 1, 1943

There isn't much new since I last wrote but I'll try to give you some news.

I took Communion this morning in Yates Chapel. It was a very nice service.

Do you think that Lancaster and Wilmington are going to battle it out again like they did under Perkins and Berry. Cox really upset Harris didn't he.

Several squadrons from Ohio are here now. I saw one boy who left Dickinson with me - Rae de Matis.

The weather here is still mighty hot and dry.

I am looking forward to those pictures Mother is taking.

If you need any film maybe I can get some at the P.X.

How were the Brandywiners?

Will you please tell Shirley that I am not going to fly again until I get to primary.

How is the garden; Ginger?

As Uncle Marion living in Wilmington now?

It's time to fall out for parade so I'll have to close. Please excuse the cut up character of this letter but I just don't seem able to concentrate today.
