Enclosed you will find sixty dollars to deposit in my account. I would like a general financial

statement if you get the chance to make it up. Have any more War Bonds come through yet? I think that it would be a thing to invest in Building and Loan stock but it would be wise to have cash on hand for returning to college when war ends.
