It would have been done today, so it was still pretty long. Boy, we really got it from the Sophs too. I guess it wasn't as bad as some of the things that you had to do but you know how

the freshmen get kicked around.

We're having open house here tomorrow and we have to show the visitors through the houses. We're going to serve tea and I guess it will be quite formal.
