Dear Lee:-

He is giving daddy the name of a family in El Paso, so if you do get in you will have someone you can contact and not have to roam around the streets a perfect stranger. It is supposed to be a very nice family, known to both Dr. Munds and Bishop McKinstry, so if you do get the name and address be sure to call, for the Bishop is sending them a wire telling them that you will be in touch with them sometime around Christmas. I have not been over the house since lunchtime so do not know whether daddy has the information yet or not. He plans to send you a wire, but knowing the difficulty in getting telegrams thru to camps sometimes I wanted to drop this note to you, air mail, knowing it ought to reach you before the weekend. If you do have any time off I hope you meet some nice folks so that you will enjoy yourself.

After writing you concerning calling on Sunday I remembered that the y.p. choir, plus Julia and Shirley, is having a carol service Sunday evening, 26th, at 7:30, so that your call ought to get thru to us by 6:30 if possible.

This may seem a choppy note. I am head over heels in work, trying to run off the copies of the Ferris Wheel. I have all of the mimeographing to do for that and we want to get it out before Christmas if possible. Lots of love and we'll be waiting to hear from you.
