The girls say the 4 Attorneys are here.  
Bob has been given a Medical discharge,  
on account of his asthma, which was ag-  
gravated when he was sent to Texas. I  
think he will return to Delaware.

I noticed an overseas cap in your closet  
before I left. Do you want it sent to you?

I want daddy to drive down with  
both grandmothers Sunday but I don't  
know whether he will. Charlotte, Gregg +  
Dorothy are spending the weekend with  
us.
