The rest of my time I've devoted to learning how to drive, trying to get in an hour every day and I can do straight driving pretty well now. I think if I go out today that I'm going to try and start to learn how to park. That's the very hardest part of driving, isn't it? Maybe by the time you get home I'll be able to meet you at the station.

We had our first Brandywiners rehearsal on Tuesday night and got along quite well. I know a few more people than I did last year, but there seem to be quite a few new ones in this year.
