Dear Lee:-

Just a hurried note to let you know that grandmother Minker came thru the operation in fine shape and is getting along nicely at the hospital. We expect she will be coming home to us before very many days.

We are having cool, rainy days this week. Maybe by the end of the week good weather will be with us again. I hope so, for there are several graduations. Dickinson Commencement is this week, as well as Williamsport. Dr. Colona called me yesterday to invite daddy and me to ride to Carlisle Saturday afternoon with them and return Sunday; but of course with daddy preaching and our going up after Shirley we could not accept. Dr. Colona is still a trustee, you know, and the trustees are meeting this time on Saturday instead of Sunday.

The Orpheus Club is giving their spring concert tonight and I guess daddy and I will go. The boys of our glee clubs, both negro and white, have been invited and so we are sending them along with Mr. Arthur. It ought to be a real treat for them.

This week has been a rather busy one for me, for Mrs. Snyder has been out of the office on account of Mike having his tonsils out last Saturday. She is the one doing the mimeographing for the Ferris Wheel and her absence has held that up as well as piling work on me. She ought to be able to be on the job next week, however.
