Here I am again at A. W. U. S.,
just about the only place I get to
write my letters, anymore.

Boy, have we been busy with
Brandymen this week. We took
it to the Drama League and
everyone is beginning to get scared.
We've been working from 9:45
up til 11:30 or 11:45 every night
and were all dead. It's worth it
though, as the show is beginning
to shape up nicely at last. Of
course there are still a few rough
spots but were gradually ironing
them out.

This morning I decided to
move the puppys out of doors
in the shade as the garage is
stilling in the weather. I moved
them out and John cleaned their
box out good while another
day and I moved Ginger's
house. Little did we suspect that
there were hornets under the

were and suddenly they swarmed out. We ran and they nuzzled me but they stung Edward. Before we touched the house again we thoroughly squirted it with the hose.
