We arrived here yesterday about 6:45 p. m. & haven't had a chance to do anything but sit in on meetings. I will make a desperate effort to go on the boardwalk after Bishop Corsan speaks tonight. I said hello to him at breakfast this morning. He asked for you. In N. Phila. yesterday I bumped into Mrs. Andrews & Mrs. Cravel from Concord. Of course they wanted to know all about you & the rest of the family.

I leave for home late tomorrow
afternoon & will write you after
I return.

There is no ice or snow here -
quite different from Wilmington.

We have nice quarters - only
about $1\frac{1}{2}$ block from boardwalk.

We've seen the ocean from our
room. Perhaps some day we can
all come here together.
